

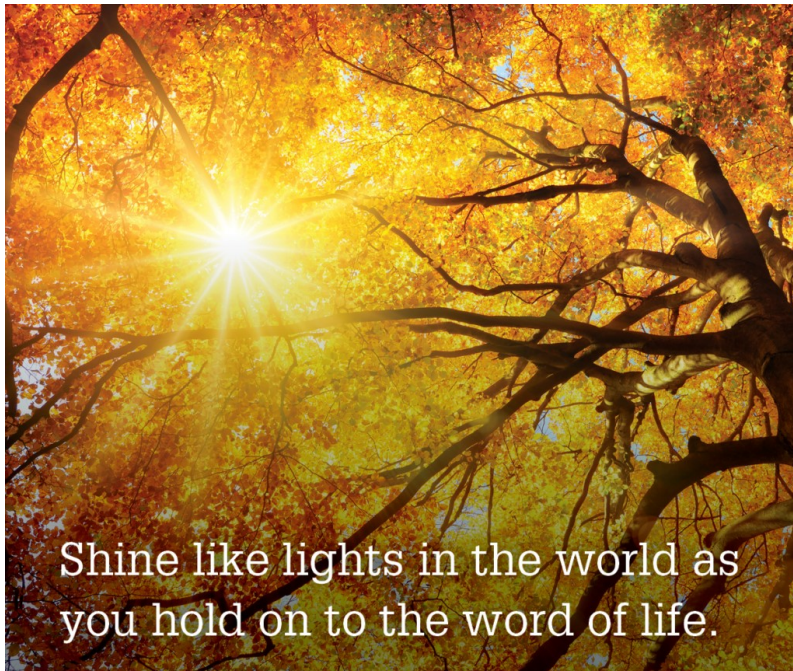

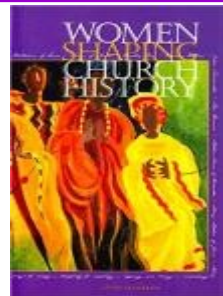

# FAITH FORMATION for YOUTH and ADULTS

## Letter from Fr. Platt regarding Confirmation



Dear Parishioners,

As you are aware, the month after I became pastor of St. Catherine of Siena Church, St. Catherine of Siena Church and St. Agnes Church began a Collaborative Committee process to merge and become one family in faith. I believe that the merger has been largely successful. I must admit, it often felt like an arduous and tedious task to merge and integrate two finance councils, two buildings and grounds councils, as well as separate liturgical calendars, not to mention the task of merging two very different Faith Formation programs. As we continued to become one family last year, our very small faith formation staff decided that we couldn't continue to run two concurrent programs, and that we would need to merge our programs more completely. It was a team decision, made by the merged faith formation staff, and approved by me.

I believe that this decision was clearly communicated to the parents of the children in the Faith Formation program at the St. Catherine of Siena Campus by our Pastoral Associate, Lori Wilson. However, it came to my attention that the decision had not been clearly communicated to the families at our St. Agnes Campus. I thought that it had been communicated clearly. As I listened to some of the parents of 8<sup>th</sup> grade students at the St. Agnes Campus program, I made a very difficult pastoral decision (in collaboration with our faith formation staff). The decision was intended for the 15 children from the former St. Agnes Church faith formation program. I decided to give them three options: 1. If parents felt that their children were already adequately prepared for Confirmation they could sign up to receive the sacrament, 2. Parents could register their children for the prep program this year and be confirmed in the spring, or 3. Parents could register their children for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade program and then continue with the 9<sup>th</sup> grade preparation program. This pastoral decision was made with the understanding that since now I was certain that the merged program had been adequately communicated at both campuses, that this would be the final year of having two different confirmation programs.

This decision has caused some confusion among the parents of our children in Faith Formation. It has also fermented the very division that I constantly prayed we would avoid as one family in faith. This last week has been a sad time for me. I apologize to you.

Since I felt the need for guidance in regard as to how to move forward in a productive manner, I called Bishop Caggiano for both spiritual and practical advice. I shared with him the whole matter. He understood the reason for my pastoral decision, and strongly supported it. However, when I shared with him the negative outcome, I asked for particular advice as to how to shepherd the parish moving ahead in regard to Confirmation. He shared that in the near future, he will be mandating a diocesan wide age for confirmation. There will no longer be different ages for the reception of the sacrament. With that in mind, he suggested that we continue to proceed with the decisions that I have made.

A Faith Formation Program is an essential component of being a parish. A good program should foster connection to the parish and participation in the Eucharist and the other sacraments; as well as create a growing awareness of social justice issues and participation in helping to make our world a kinder, more just place for all. Our program is being re-envisioned this year as it allows for growth in understanding the faith, fosters connection to the Sunday Eucharist, and allows for events that help families to live their faith. It begins in Kindergarten and follows through ninth grade. Students are prepared to celebrate the sacraments of reconciliation and First Eucharist in 2nd grade and Confirmation in 9th grade. We are also exploring ways to continue to invite our high school students to participate in parish-supported justice work that blends creating a better world with our faith.

Another goal we have for this year is to create a faith formation advisory board. We are looking for people interested in faith formation to help with this. If you have an interest in exploring serving on this board that will meet four times a year with a clear mission please email Mrs. Wilson at [lori.wilson@stc-sta.org](mailto:lori.wilson@stc-sta.org).

I once again apologize for any confusion or division that I may have caused. Please continue to pray for me as your pastor, and for our one family of faith.

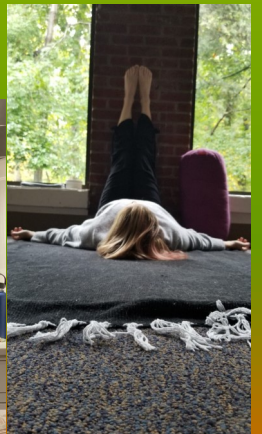
