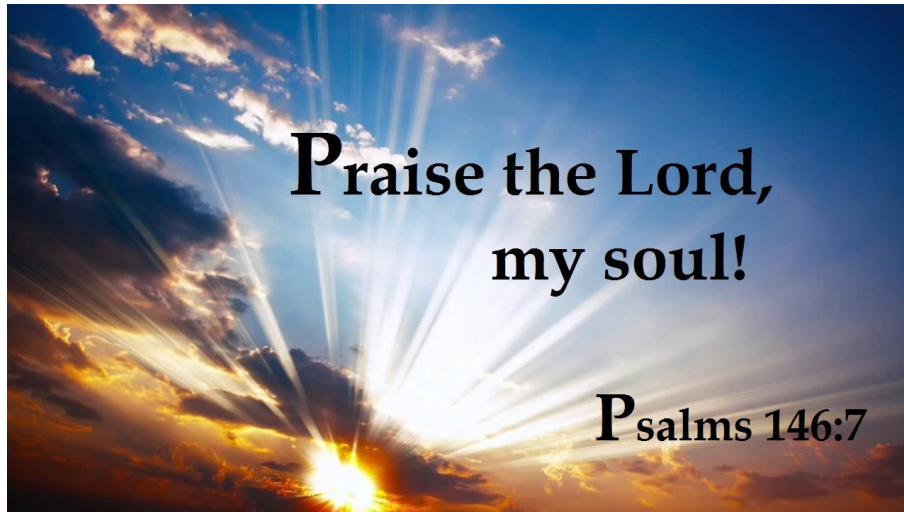

4 Reasons Your Child Should Be an Altar Server



- 1. One less kid in the pews.** Practically speaking, if you have four children and one or more of them are serving up on the altar, that could help cut down on the chaos factor by nearly half!
- 2. Community with peers.** Being an altar server could have something of a “cool” factor while setting an example for others. It’s also something kids can do together. We’re all called to live in community and I can’t think of a more positive way than being an altar server.
- 3. Respect and understanding of the Mass.** This is a hands-on way to teach the history and ritualism of the Mass; pointing out key moments during the liturgy of why we do what we do when attending Mass. And as an altar server you can’t (or shouldn’t) zone out because “missing your cue” can have embarrassing consequences during the liturgy.
- 4. An opportunity to build self-confidence.** While serving on the altar will often be accompanied by a normal case of anxious nerves at the beginning, with time, these “jitters” will subside as confidence in what you’re doing increases.
